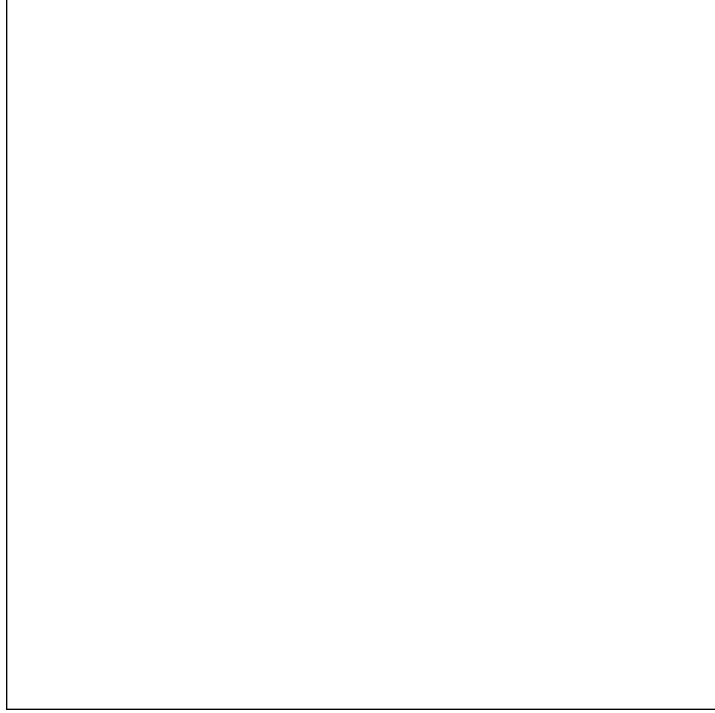

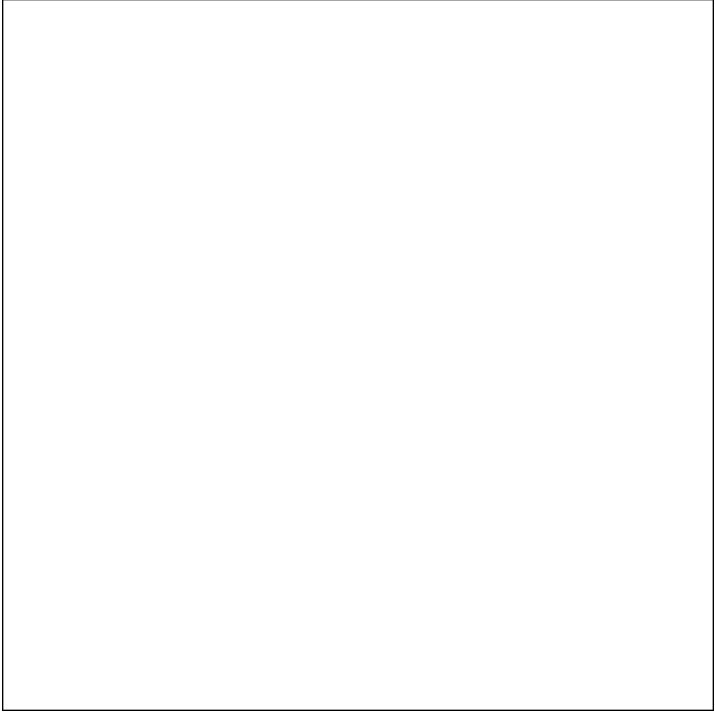
Once upon a time, there lived a  
happy family.



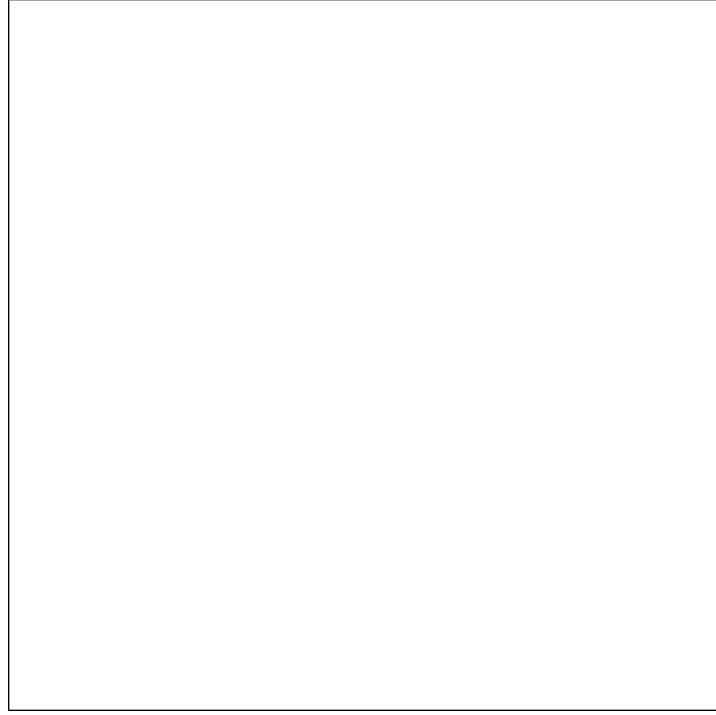
They never fought with each other.

singing into the morning light.

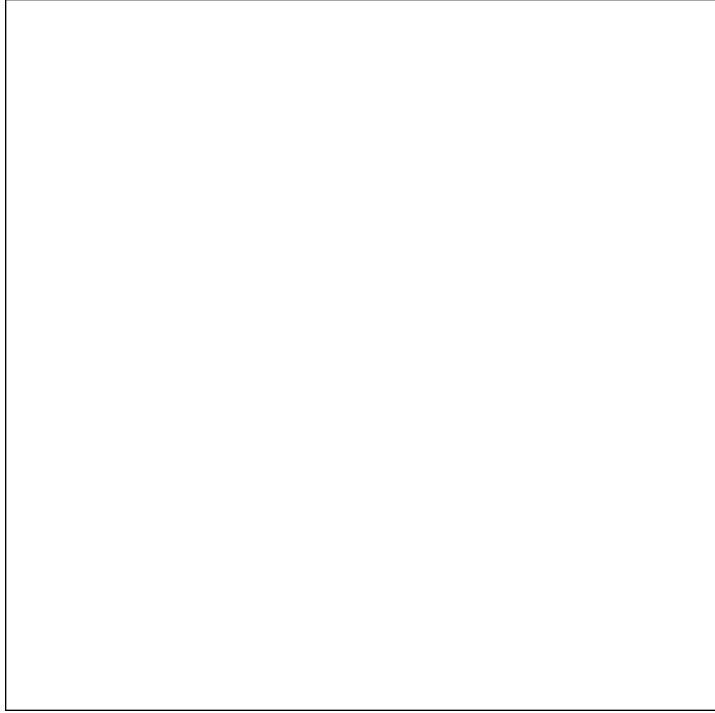


But one of the boys longed to go out  
in the sunlight.

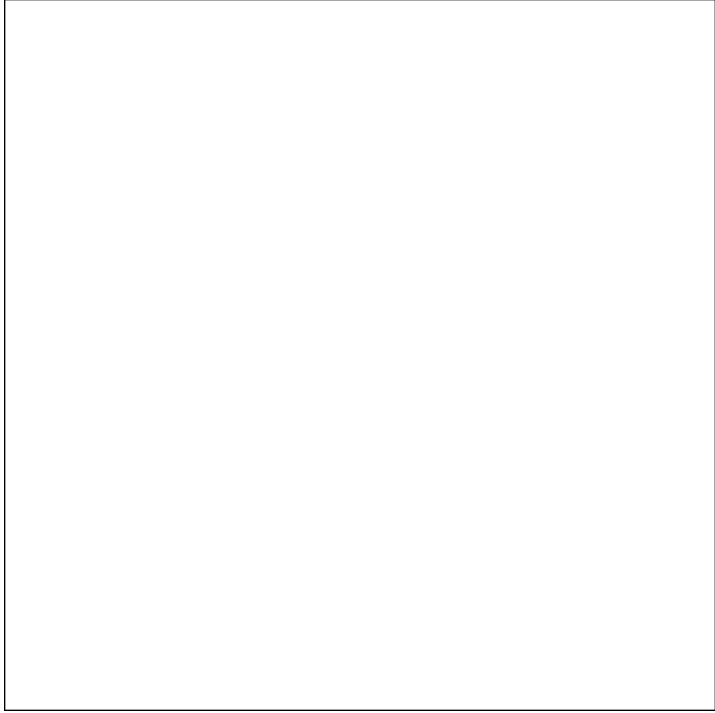


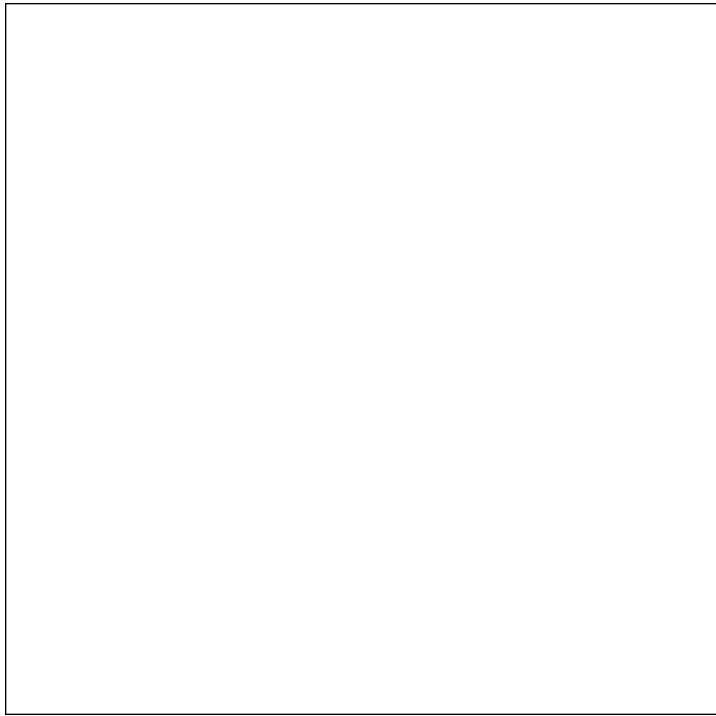
They took their bird brother up to a

But they made a plan. They shaped the lump of melted wax into a bird.

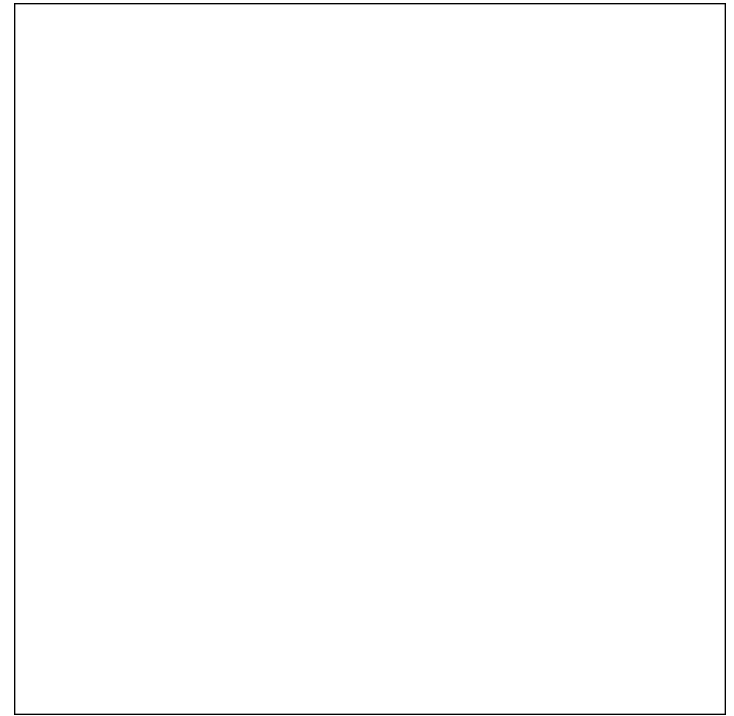


One day the longing was too strong. His brothers warned him...
